### 1. Please Select One Award Category:

**Corporate Board of Director**

A woman who has advanced to be a board of director or add additional directorships in a public or private corporation in the period from 2007 to 2011. Also serves as a mentor and advocate to other professional women within their organization, or through outside business associations or mentee programs.

**Corporate Fast Tracker**

A woman who has advanced to a leadership role at the senior management level in the period from 2007 to 2011. For example: a professional woman who is running a P&L as a Business Unit President or Finance, HR, Operations, or Sales leader. Also serves as a mentor and advocate to other professional women within their organization, or through outside business associations or mentee programs.

**Entrepreneurial Success Story**

A professional woman who between the period of 2007 to 2011 has built a new company or a new business unit that achieved at least \$1M or greater in annual revenues. Or, one whom purchased a company and grew a business unit annual revenue by \$3M or double-digit percentage (10 % or greater in a single year, for example) over the 4 year time period. Qualified applicants must be women who are either the founder or majority owner, or serve as an innovator inside a corporation with a CEO or President responsibility/title. Also serves as a mentor and advocate to other professional women within their organization, or through outside business associations or mentee programs.

**Transition to Transformation Success Story**

A professional woman who between the period of 2007 to 2011 has leveraged a job loss, layoff, or work transition to rebuild a new career path that has enabled them to apply new strengths or skills in an entrepreneurial, corporate, or non-profit executive role. Also serves as a mentor and advocate to other professional women within their organization, or through outside business associations or mentee programs.
